Dear Judge Shea:

On January 20, 2009, Mr. Morales appeared before Your Honor for the offense of Conspiracy to Possess With the Intent to Distribute 1,000 Grams or More of a Mixture of Substance Containing a Detectable Amount of Heroin. He was sentenced to 336 months imprisonment, followed by 10 years of supervised release.

On November 18, 2016, Mr. Morales' sentence was amended to 16 years imprisonment followed by seven years of supervised release. The following special conditions were imposed: substance abuse treatment, mental health treatment, no firearms, search, 250 hours of community service at a rate of 10 hours per month, shall not reside in Bridgeport, Connecticut, and supervised release may be modified upon showing fulltime employment.

Mr. Morales' term of supervision commenced on July 2, 2020 and is scheduled to terminate on July 1, 2027. Since his release from the Bureau of Prisons, Mr. Morales has maintained fulltime employment with Siles and Sons Inc., as a CDL Driver, where he drives a dump truck. He obtained this position back in September 2019, while residing at the half-way house. He has since received two raises, while working for the company.

On March 31, 2021, Mr. Morales successfully completed both substance abuse and mental health treatment. Mr. Morales has not completed any community service hours to date. He has concerns about COVID-19 and bringing the virus back to his elderly parents. Mr. Morales has been provided different locations to complete his community service hours, in the event the Court does not modify his community service condition.

Additionally, Mr. Morales has maintained a stable residence, living with his elderly parents in DeLand, Florida. When not working he assists his parents around the residence. Mr. Morales has also been working on his relationship with his children, attending their sporting events and ensuring he demonstrates being a positive role model to them.

Since his commencement of supervision, there has been no known non-compliance to report.
