ORDER FOR A PRESENTENCE INVESTIGATION AND REPORT

This defendant having been found guilty of one or more offenses against the United States, the probation office is ordered to conduct an investigation and prepare a (check one) standard report modified report, to be used by this court in sentencing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

At least 42 days before sentencing or by Jul 22, 2014, the initial presentence report shall be disclosed to counsel.

Within 14 days after receiving the report or by Aug 5, 2014, the counsel shall submit to the probation office any objections in writing, or a statement that there are no objections.

No later than 10 days after the deadline for counsel's objections or Aug 15, 2014, the probation officer shall submit the final presentence report and any addenda to the court and disclose the revised presentence report to the defendant and counsel for the defendant and the government.
