Dear Judge Bryant:

After being Arrested I was Remanded to the Wyatt Federal Detention Center in Rhode Island. You sentenced me on October 12th, 2016. At the time of sentencing you gave me a Sentence of 72 months.

You Also gave me 1 year, two months and 11 days of jail credit for the time I spent in the Detention Center from 7-13-15 to 10-12-16.

With a 72 month sentence minus the 14 months and 11 days credit this left a balance of 57 months, 20 Days left to my sentence.

On November 4th, 2016 I was transferred to FMC Carswell in Ft. Worth TX. Today is May 20th, 2020. I have been in custody here at Carswell for 3 years, 5 months and 16 days.

This means I should have credit for 56 months and 6 days served. I have also Received 7 months of good time. That would total 63 months total. I have served 5 years, 2 1/2 months of my 6 year sentence.

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So why am I still here? I have gone to my counselor, to my case manager, to records, I have reached out to everyone I can. I sent a letter to Region. No one will respond.

Although they have the paperwork showing the time served at Wyatt, I believe they did not actually include the time in their calculations.

Will you please help me and order an immediate release for the time already served? I have bad lungs. I am on oxygen 24 hours per day. I receive monthly transfusions for my lungs and am living on the Chronic Care Unit here at Carzwell. It is like living in a badly run nursing home.

I am over 63 years old and scared to death about the COVID-19 virus. When it hits the floor I am on. According to the CDC I am at a high risk to die if I catch the virus. Please help me.
