**NOTICE OF PETITION FOR EXONERATION
FROM OR LIMITATION OF LIABILITY**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that LUIGI CANGIANO (hereinafter "Petitioner"), as Owner of the 1994 23-foot Wellcraft Eclipse #236 powerboat M/V "MARGARITAVILLE", Hull No. WELEGA76L394, Registration No. CT4425BD (hereinafter "the Vessel"), has filed a Petition for Exoneration from or Limitation of Liability pursuant to 46 U.S.C. § 30501, *et. seq.*, and Rule F of the Supplemental Rules for Certain Admiralty or Maritime Claims and Asset Forfeiture Actions of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, for exoneration from or limitation of liability for all claims for any loss or injury arising out of the Vessel's voyage on September 17, 2018 (the "Incident"), during which three claimants have alleged that the Vessel made contact with a bridge abutment and/or piling, while upon the waters of the New Haven Harbor, New Haven, Connecticut, a navigable waterway of the United States, as more fully described in the Complaint; and

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that all persons, firms, entities, or corporations having any claims or suits against the Petitioner arising or resulting from the boating Incident must file a claim, as provided in Rule F of the Supplemental Rules for Certain Admiralty or Maritime

Claims and Asset Forfeiture Actions of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, with the Clerk of this Court at the Richard C. Lee U. S. Courthouse, 141 Church Street, New Haven, CT 06510, and must deliver or mail to the attorneys for Petitioner, Charles E. Murphy, Lennon, Murphy & Phillips, LLC, 1599 Post Road East, Westport, CT 06880, a copy on or before the **29th day of May, 2019**, or be defaulted. Personal attendance of claimants is not required for filing claims or service of them.

If any claimant would like to contest either the right to exoneration from liability or the right to limitation of liability, he or she shall file and serve on the attorneys for Petitioner an answer to the Complaint on or before **May 29, 2019**, unless his or her claim has included an answer, so designated, or be defaulted.
